

Privacy Policy

The present confidentiality policy defines and informs you of the way in which the site www.mybdspartner.com (hereafter the "Site"), as data controller, uses and protects the information that you transmit to it.

This privacy policy may be modified or completed at any time by the Site. The date of its update will then be expressly specified. These modifications are binding on you as soon as they are put online and we advise you to consult them regularly.

By using the Site, you expressly agree to the Site's privacy policy, of which you declare that you are fully aware.

1. Information gathering

The Site collects information when you use it.

If you wish to post one or more ads, the Site collects the following information: e-mail address, phone number (optional), password (encrypted in database), nickname, age, gender and gender searched, geographical information (country, region, county, city, zip code), photo(s).

In addition, the Site automatically receives and records information from your connection terminal and browser, including your IP address, when you connect to the Site.

The Site retains this data as long as the ad remains active. You can request the deletion of this data and your ads by email or do it yourself from the ads management interface.

2. Use of information

All information collected from you may be used to:

- Provide personalized advertising content
- Improve the Site
- Contact you by e-mail
- Interact with other users of the Site
- Use the chat or "messenger" of the Site (optional and edited by a third company)

This processing is necessary for the performance of the Site's obligations and is based on its legitimate interest in providing you with relevant content.

3. Privacy

The Site is the sole owner of the information collected on the Site. Your personal information will not be sold, exchanged, transferred, or given to another company for commercial purposes, without your consent.

This data may however be entrusted to subcontractors for the proper execution of the services offered on the Site or to third parties responsible for the management and/or operation of the Site, who are in no case authorized to use your data for purposes outside the strict scope of their mission or to sell, exchange or transfer your data to third parties.

Your personal data may only be disclosed in application of a law, a regulation or a court order.

Your non-private data, i.e. data that does not allow you to be identified, may be provided to third parties for statistical, marketing or advertising purposes.

4. Protection of information

The Site implements a variety of security measures to keep your personal information safe.

In particular, the Site uses state-of-the-art encryption to protect sensitive information transmitted online. The Site also protects your information offline. Only employees who need to perform a specific job (for example, customer service) have access to personally identifiable information.

The Site ensures that any service provider or subcontractor it may use to collect and process the data you provide to us has adequate safeguards for confidentiality, use and protection of the data.

The computers and servers used to store personally identifiable information are kept in a secure environment.

5. Right of access, rectification, and opposition

You have the right to access, limit, rectify and oppose the use of your personal data transmitted to the Site.

In view of the Site's security and confidentiality obligations in the processing of personal data, the Site may require elements to prove your identity. In case of reasonable doubt about your identity, the Site may ask you to provide a copy of an identity document (identity card, passport, driving license).

The Site will respond within a maximum of one month following receipt of your request.

6. Policy on the use of cookies

When you connect to the Site, the Site may install a cookie on the hard disk of your terminal in order to guarantee you a smooth and optimal navigation on the Site.

"Cookies" (also called "connection cookies") allow the Site to recognize your computer, tablet or cell phone in order to personalize the services offered through the Site.

To inform you of this, a banner is displayed at the bottom of your screen when you connect to the Site. You can refuse at any time the deposit of cookies on your terminal by configuring your Internet browser. However, in such a case, the Site cannot guarantee the optimal functioning of the Site and cannot be held responsible for any consequences related to the alteration of your browsing conditions on the Site which would result from your choice to refuse or block the cookies necessary for the proper functioning of the Site.

The information collected through cookies does not allow you to be identified by name and is only intended to help the Site to increase its performance.

In accordance with the recommendations of the CNIL, the cookies strictly necessary for the functioning of the Site are not subject to any prior obligation on your part. On the other hand, your express consent is required prior to the use of cookies issued by third parties, which are subject to the confidentiality policies of the latter, which can be consulted on their websites. These cookies may be audience measurement cookies, advertising cookies, or social network sharing cookies.
